Record of Decisions of October 2022 Finance Committee Meeting

7:30 pm, 17 October 2022 Conference Room, Gilberdyke War Memorial Hall

In attendance:

Councillor Paul Bryan, Councillor Sam Taylor-Dunn, Councillor John Walker, Councillor Kevin Woolass, Jake Wilde (Parish Clerk).

That the Parish Council agree:

- 1. The Finance Committee Terms of Reference.
- 2. The Model Financial Regulations.
- 3. The Model Grant templates, with the following annotations:
 - (a) On the Grant Application, the figure at Question 9 to be £500
 - (b) On the Grant Application, the figure at Question 10 to be £500
 - (c) On the Grant Guidance Notes, the sentence under "Amount of Grant" to read, "Applications for up to £10,000 will be considered, however the average allocation is between £250 and £500."
- 4. That, should Recommendation 3 be agreed, the Clerk will write to local charities to advise them of the process.
- 5. That the Clerk should draw up a Reserves Policy based upon best practice from other parish council's policies, for agreement at the December Parish Council meeting, with the following types of reserve:
 - (a) General. This should be 50% of the annual precept and designated to ensure that employee salaries, pension contributions and tax and national insurance payments are made.
 - (b) Specific. This should be for specific, individual projects where the final budget has been set and agreed.
 - (c) Allocated. This should be for specific, individual projects where the final budget for the project is unknown, but where an estimate has been made.
- 6. That the Clerk should draw up an Investment Policy based upon best practice from other parish council's policies, for agreement at the December Parish Council meeting.
- 7. To hold an initial meeting to discuss the 2023/24 Precept on Wednesday 14 December.
