Name:		Services Committee
Membership:		Five (5) members of the council
Purpose:		 To set strategic direction and provide long-term vision for the delivery of Parish Council services, including Gilberdyke Youth Project Streetscene Gilberdyke Village Playground Jubilee Pond Emergency Planning Allotments Other leisure facilities and activities To provide assurance to the Parish Council that services are being provided effectively and efficiently To consider offering new services in response to citizen demand, both current and anticipated
Conditions:	1	Membership of the Committee to be decided upon its creation and the membership of the committee to be appointed at the Annual Council Meeting
	2	Meetings to be convened on a quarterly basis within the requirements of the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 12, para 10 and the Public Bodies (Admission to meetings) Act 1960, para 1
	3	Minutes to be presented to the next meeting of the parish council
	4	The Committee may co-opt to fill temporary vacancies
	5	The Committee is empowered to invite specialist professional Officers or advisors to attend meetings to provide guidance as to matters under discussion



- Restrictions: 6 Only Members of the parish council may be members of the Committee
 - 7 Only members of the Committee may speak at Committee meetings other than by the resolution of the Committee or if specifically summoned
 - 8 The quorum shall be three (3)
 - 9 The Parish Council's Code of Conduct and attendant regulations apply to this Committee
 - 10 The Committee may resolve decisions.
 - 11 The Committee may set up Sub-committees or Working Groups for specific projects
